In 2025 the Alfried Krupp-Foundation grants 35 scholarships to pupils in Essen for a "On the Job Training in Foreign Companies". The pupils are on average between 15 and 17 years old. The project is planned and organised by the Essen Economic Development Corporation (EWG).

This programme was established for the first time in 1998 by the Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Foundation. Since the beginning, over 1000 pupils have successfully completed this programme in about 300 companies in 35 countries.

On this basis, 35 pupils from schools in Essen have the opportunity to get to know the requirements for their future profession and to be prepared for their career.

Arrival abroad: Monday, March 23, 2026  
Departure abroad: Friday, April 17, 2026

## Practical Training Objectives

- To become familiar with company structures and procedures
- To raise the awareness of business interrelations
- To appreciate different languages and cultures and to consider this a way and means of developing social competence

## Project Financing

The internship provider receives an amount of € 1.600 per intern for:

- **Accommodation** in a guest family, boarding house, flat or hotel (15-year-old students are accommodated in pairs if not in a host family)
- **Full board** (all-day catering, also at weekends and on public holidays)
- **Local travel expenses** (e.g. bus ticket to the workplace)
- **Excursions and sightseeing**
- **Transfer:** The internship provider undertakes to organise the interns transfer from/to the train station/airport on the day of arrival and departure

## Flights / Insurances

- Flight or train tickets will be booked by the foundation
- The interns are covered by accident, health and liability insurance for the duration of their internship abroad
